RETURN TO SCHOOL:

As I mentioned in previous communications, we have two INSET days at the beginning of the term – Thursday 1^{st} and Friday 2^{nd} September.

Children in Y1 – Y6 will return to school on Monday 5th September. FS1 and FS2 pupils have been allocated a personal start-date.

Our school start and finish times will remain the same from September. Gates will open at the usual time of 8.45a.m. and close at 8.55a.m. Children in FS2 – Y6 will depart at 3p.m. Children in FS1 morning sessions will depart at 11.45a.m. Afternoon only, sessions will end at 3p.m. Children attending full day sessions will depart at 2.45p.m. unless topping up the session for the afternoon to 3p.m.

We will continue with the same procedures for entry and exit of school. Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 pupils should arrive at lower playground gates. Key Stage 2 pupils should arrive at the main entrance gate.

UNIFORM

We will continue to allow pupils to attend school in P.E clothing on P.E days.

ADDITIONAL KIT/ITEMS

All medication should be brought into school on the first day of return. If your child's medication is due to expire, please arrange for replacements in time for the September 5th start.
