Dear families,

I hope you are all keeping well.

Thank you so much for attending our parent meetings this term. Having a one to conversation with parents is really valuable to us and helps us in the drive to provide the best for your children. We hope you found the meetings to be a positive experience for you, too. If you have any further questions relating to your child's education and/or welfare, please do get in touch. It is our aim to ensure our parent partnerships are as positive as possible for the benefit of all pupils.

Assessments:

Right now, our pupils in Key Stages 1 and 2 (Year groups 1 to 6) are carrying out assessments in the core subject areas of reading writing and maths. Outcomes of the assessments will provide teachers with a range of information to show how secure their pupils are with the learning they have experienced so far.

In the new year, pupil progress meetings will take place to discuss the outcomes for each child and any next steps and interventions to be put in place.

In the Foundation Stage, our teachers are gathering information to check progress made since the children took the baseline assessments in September.

All children working within the Read, Write Inc. programme have been assessed for phonic progress. In the new year, teachers will update you with any new activities for supporting pupils in the home.

Christmas performances:

The coming week is due to be a very busy one with performances taking place for all year groups. Please ensure you bring your tickets along with you to avoid delay in entering the hall. Our morning performances begin at 9.15a.m. and afternoon ones, 2.15p.m. We will open the school gates to parents at 9.05a.m. and at 1.50p.m. to enable families to take their seats before the pupils enter the hall.

As with all Christmas performances – we never charge for tickets. Instead, we choose to hold a collection for a good cause.

This year, as we have already established good partnerships with Sunnyside Supplies, our collection will support them in their drive to maintain their social supermarket within our local community. On

performance days, we invite you to 'bring a tin when you come in,' or drop a few pennies into the collection bucket \odot
